



- Students with more than 4 courses not packed in the same UEL sequence, will need to finish the courses first.
- Students with less / or 4 courses not packed in the same UEL sequence, will need to finish the courses first.
  - pay admission fees 500£
  - Then register the missing courses additionally during the 2 main upcoming semesters [fall-spring]






